"In previous years we have had permission to collect at Coles each day for a fortnight.

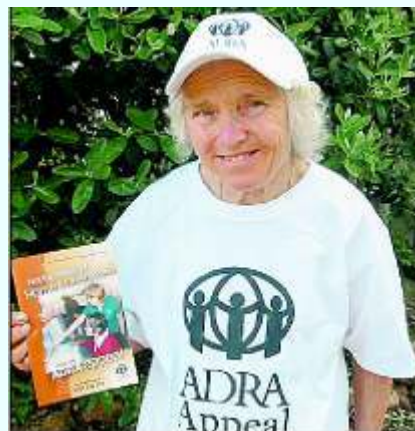
"This year we have been allocated Wednesday, Thursday and Friday for three consecutive weeks.
